

STANDARD CLEANING PROCEDURES



- **Clean immediately after use to avoid calcium deposits and build up of dirt.**
- **Use a soft sponge, warm water and liquid soap.**
- **If calcium deposits have built up, you can use citric acid to remove it.**
- **If basin becomes blocked, remove the bottle trap and clean.**
- **Minor scratches and abrasions can be polished out with a mild polishing compound as used on car repairs.**
- **Never leave soap shampoo pools, these can cause permanent stains.**
- **Do not allow abrasive chemicals and cosmetics to come into contact with toilet seat as they can cause damage.**
- **Never mix different cleaners in the WC- they can react and give off poisonous gas.**
- **Do not use bleach in the cistern – this can damage the internal fittings.**
