



- Clean immediately after use to avoid calcium deposits and build up of dire.
- · Use a soft sponge, warm water and liquid soap.
- · If calcium deposits have built up, you can use citric acid to remove it.
- If basin becomes blocked, remove the bottle trap and clean.
- Minor scratches and abrasions can be polished out with a mild polishing compound as used on car repairs.
- Never leave soap shampoo pools, these can cause permanent stains.
- Do not allow abrasive chemicals and cosmetics to come into contact with toilet seat as they can cause damage.
- Never mix different cleaners in the WC- they can react and give off poisonous gas.
- Do not use bleach in the cistern this can damage the internal fittings.
