

### NEVER USE CEMENT WHEN SECURING A TOILET PAN TO THE FLOOR



- Cement is a rigid material that does not provide any flexibility or shock absorption. Toilets can experience minor movements due to usage, which could potentially lead to cracks in the toilet or the floor if it is fixed in place with cement.
- Using cement around the base of the toilet will make repairs extremely difficult. The cement will make it difficult to remove or replace the toilet without completely damaging the toilet or the floor.
- If a toilet is cemented to the floor, detecting and fixing leaks becomes very complicated.
- There are hygiene concerns with cement because cement is porous and it can absorb water leading to unpleasant odours.
